#### 4.1 Deputation - Blooming Tasmania

#### **DECISION STATEMENT:**

To receive a deputation at 10.00am from Mrs Jane Teniswood, Chair and Mrs Jennie Chapman, Vice Chair (Blooming Tasmania).

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Strategic Planning and Policy Committee receives a deputation from Mrs Jane Teniswood (Chair) and Mrs Jennie Chapman (Vice Chair) regarding the outcome of last year's Festival and Blooming Tasmania's plans for 2017.

Ms Teniswood thanked the Mayor, Alderman A M van Zetten, Alderman Danny Gibson and Council Officers for their assistance with the inaugural Blooming Tasmania Flower and Garden Festival held in 2016.

Blooming Tasmania is a not for profit, voluntary organisation founded in 2004 and is a State-wide body. Blooming Tasmania works co-operatively with Tourism Tasmania to promote related activities and opportunities. Blooming Tasmania's major activity is its annual publication of the Blooming Tasmania Guide which lists gardens open to visitors, related accommodation sites, events, tour companies and businesses associated with garden tourism. The Blooming Tasmania web-site is linked to the Discover Tasmania web-site in order to maximise tourism potential. A recently conducted Tasmanian Visitor Survey indicated garden tourists stay longer and spend more per person than in any other tourism sector and one in five visitors indicate gardening as a prime reason for visiting the State.

Ms Teniswood discussed other issues associated with Blooming Tasmania's operations including inter- and intra-state activities, overseas invitations, marketing, sponsorships and strategic brochure display opportunities. Ms Teniswood stated that, as a not for profit organisation, it is important to engage in strategic partnerships of benefit to all parties and working with the City of Launceston, its Aldermen and gardening experts would be fundamental in the success of the group.

Aldermen thanked Ms Teniswood for her presentation and discussed a number of ideas that could assist the organisation's activities into the future.
