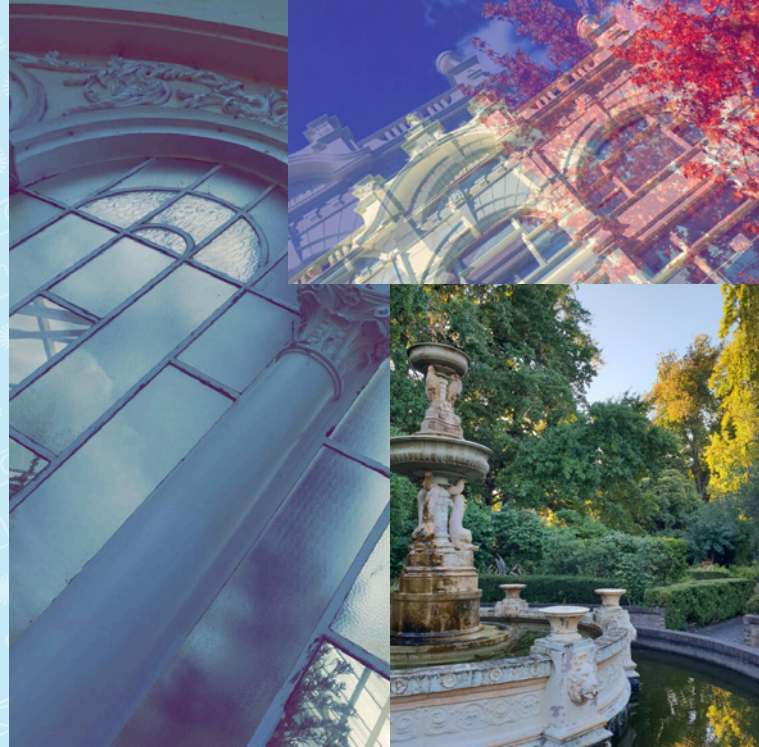


# Heritage Snap!

The City of Launceston's Heritage Advisory Committee invites you to enter the 2019 Heritage Awards photographic competition for students – HERITAGE SNAP!



This exciting competition is open to school aged students, and will be divided into three sections for judging: Primary School; Grade 7–10; and Grade 11–12 students.

## What's it all about?

- Raising the profile and understanding of the significance of Launceston's historic cultural heritage.
- Promoting our heritage environments and attributes in a relevant and contemporary way.
- Highlighting the depth of Launceston's built heritage by focussing on specific details and attributes often overlooked.
- Inspiring our young people to take an interest in and get involved with our built heritage.

## This year's theme

This year's theme is 'This Place Matters', to align with the National Trust Heritage Festival for 2019.

We would love to see your photos of significant heritage places in and around Launceston that matter most to you or your family. These places might include streets, whole buildings, gardens or other special spaces. It may just be a small part of one of these; showing whatever it is that makes the place special to you.

**We encourage you to explore the city and photograph these important places, and request that parents and/or teachers be responsible for the safety of children in the city.**

## ENTRIES

### What you need to enter

All entries should include a photograph (high quality digital submission preferred) and a brief written description of the image, explaining why the place matters.

Please ensure that all entries include your name, age and grade, an email address so we can contact you, and that they are uploaded no later than 4pm on the closing date.

### How to enter

This year entry is via the City of Launceston webpage where entries must be uploaded using the online form.

## AWARDS

Winners will receive a certificate and prizes as follows.

**Primary School section** – a framed print of the winning image and a photographic voucher

**Grades 7–10 section** – a framed print of the winning image and a photographic voucher

**Grades 11–12 section** – a voucher for photographic equipment to the value of \$500

## JUDGING

Entries will be considered by the members of the Launceston City Council Heritage Advisory Committee and relevant experts as required.

The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

## ANNOUNCEMENT OF WINNERS

The announcement of awards in all categories will be made at an awards ceremony to be held at 4pm on Thursday 23 May 2019 at the Town Hall Reception Room, St John Street, Launceston.

Winning images and competition entries will be on public display as a digital exhibition through the Council's facebook page and website and may also be included in a gallery exhibition in the future
