- Highlighting the depth of Launceston's built heritage by focusing on specific details and attributes often overlooked.
- Inspiring our young people to take an interest in and get involved with our built heritage.

This year's theme

This year's theme is *'If walls could talk...'*

We would love to see your photos of places in and around Launceston that speak to you.

These places might include buildings or other structures and it may be just a small part of one of these; whatever is of interest to you.

We encourage you to explore the city and photograph these important places, and request that parents and/or teachers be responsible for the safety of children in the city.

ENTRIES

What you need to enter

All entries should include a photograph (high quality digital submission preferred) and a brief written description to go with the image, explaining what the place, building or object says to you.

Please ensure that all entries include your name, age and grade, an email address so we can contact you, and that they are uploaded no later than 4pm on the closing date.

Entries will be considered by the members of the Launceston City Council Heritage Advisory Committee and relevant experts as required.

The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

AWARDS

Winners will receive a certificate and prizes as follows.

- **Primary School section:**
a framed print of the winning image and a photographic voucher.
- **Grades 7–10 section:**
a framed print of the winning image and a photographic voucher.
- **Grades 11–12 section:**
a voucher for photographic equipment to the value of \$500.

The announcement of awards in all categories will be made at an awards ceremony. The date and location are to be confirmed.

Winning images and competition entries will be on public display as a digital exhibition through the Council's facebook page and website and may also be included in a gallery exhibition in the future.
