THIS YEAR'S THEME

This year's theme is 'Young at heart'.

Launceston has always been a city of innovation - many of the buildings we see now as old were once the 'latest thing' and show the excitement and creativity of earlier times. We would love to see your images of places in and around Launceston that you think are still vibrant, and hear how you imagine their youth.

These could be buildings or places you love or where you've had good times, and they could be whole buildings or small parts of them - whatever is of interest to you.

ENTRIES

What you need to enter: All entries should include a photograph (high quality digital submission preferred) and a brief written description to go with the image, explaining why the place, building or object interests you and what makes it 'young at heart'.

Please ensure that all entries include your name, age and grade, an email address so we can contact you, and that they are uploaded no later than 4pm on the closing date.

JUDGING

Entries will be considered by the members of the Launceston City Council Heritage Advisory Committee and relevant experts as required.

The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

AWARDS

Winners will receive a certificate and prizes as follows.

- Primary School section: a framed print of the winning image and a photographic voucher.
- Year 7–10 section: a framed print of the winning image and a photographic voucher.
- Year 11–12 section: a voucher for photographic equipment to the value of \$500.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF WINNERS

The announcement of awards in all categories will be made at an awards ceremony. The date and location are to be confirmed.

Winning images and competition entries will be on public display as a digital exhibition through the Council's facebook page and website and may also be included in a gallery exhibition in the future.
