On 10 March 2022, the City of Launceston (Council) passed a motion that it intended to create a new by-law. The title of the proposed by-law is the On-Street Parking Penalties By-Law No. 1 of 2023 (by-law).

The objective of the by-law is to provide Council with an efficient and effective means of enforcing parking controls under sections 97, 98 and 99 of the *Local Government* (*Highways*) Act 1982 (the Act). The by-law will achieve this objective by ensuring that Council officers can continue to issue infringement notices as an alternative to prosecution.

The by-law has no impact on any applicable parking fees required to utilise a parking space, and only becomes applicable in instances of non-compliance with the Act. The by-law will have no effect on permissive parking under the *Road Rules 2019*, or on the use of Council's off-street carparks.

The primary feature of the by-law is to move away from fixed penalties expressed as dollar values, to penalties that are expressed as a proportion of a penalty unit calculated under the *Penalty Units and Other Penalties Act* 1987. The change will see an initial increase of ~39% to existing penalties, which will index over time.

The by-law will also repeal Part 7 of the Parking By-Law Number No. 2 of 2013.
