7.2.1 Mr Ron Baines - University of Tasmania Move to Inveresk

1. Is Council considering the University of Tasmania's (UTAS) proposal to utilise the Albert Hall for up to 600 students and will UTAS reimburse the Council?

The Mayor, Alderman A M van Zetten, responded by saying that the proposal was part of the current UTAS Master Plan which has been circulated for public comment and input and if a request is forwarded to Council it would be considered. Reimbursement would occur if the proposal was accepted.

2. Is the faux railway station at Number 2 Invermay Road, Invermay to be demolished to make way for the area's use by UTAS?

The Mayor, Alderman A M van Zetten, responded by saying that he was unaware of any such plans.

Mr Michael Tidey (Acting General Manager) added that the Community Consultation Plan circulated by UTAS does include different uses for the property, however, no formal application has been received at this stage.

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7.2.2 Mr Ron Baines - National Automobile Museum Move

1. Does Council intend to sell the land made vacant by the move from this site by the Automobile Museum? What is the site vaued at?

The Mayor, Alderman A M van Zetten, stated that the Council would be willing to sell the land if it was required to do so and a current valuation is being prepared.

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- 7.2.3 Mr Basil Fitch University of Tasmania Move to Inveresk
 - 1. Is it not time the Council levelled with Launceston ratepayers with regard to the UTAS move?

The Mayor, Alderman A M van Zetten, stated that the UTAS Master Plan is currently undergoing a public consultation process and has not been finalised as yet. Once a report is received by Council, necessary discussions and decisions will occur as appropriate.

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- 7.2.4 Mr Basil Fitch National Automobile Museum Move
 - 1. Will the ratepayers be required to fund such a move?

The Mayor, Alderman A M van Zetten, responded by saying that if a move does eventuate, it is likely that a land swap will occur - one valuation for the other.

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7.2.5 Mr Basil Fitch - Fragrance Hotel Group

1. Will Council take into consideration all developmental matters in cases such as this?

The Mayor, Alderman A M van Zetten, responded by saying that all relevant matters would be considered with such proposals.
