We are situated at and our horse paddocks and horse training arena are proposed Holiday Unit/Air BNB and gravel road to this unit. Therefore we are concerned the Air BNB is not being built as stated in the Launceston Planning Scheme schedule which states "Buildings, other than outbuildings, must be setback from a side boundary no less than 20m 'ref: 13.4.3 A3.1", it is actually only 10 m from the Boundary.

We feel that having strangers, unfamiliar with horses so close to the Boundary, where the horses live and train, would be detrimental to their wellbeing if said people try to interact with them or make undue noise, this will also affect my training in the arena, horses are very skittish and very sensitive to unexpected movement or noises. As this is a life style that we have chosen and lived for over 30 years we feel that having an Air BNB so close to our boundary will affect the privacy and character in what is a rural area and life style.

Therefore, we are asking for you to reconsider this area of the proposed development and we refer to the Launceston Planning Scheme schedule ref; 13.4.3 A3.1 "Buildings, other than outbuildings, must be setback from a side Boundary no less than 20m.
