


## TOWARDS A SUSTAINABLE AND ACCESSIBLE TRANSPORT SYSTEM

The Greater Launceston Transport Vision and Work Plan is a collaborative project between Greater Launceston Councils and the Tasmanian Government aimed at providing a strategic vision for the long term growth of the Greater Launceston area, and enhance the mobility, liveability and prosperity of the region.

The Greater Launceston Transport Vision establishes a framework for the sustainable and accessible growth of Greater Launceston's transport system to facilitate the city's growth and prosperity in the future.

The objective of the Vision is to ensure people are connected to their place of work, shopping, schools, essential services and leisure activities.

### **Greater Launceston Transport Vision**


The Vision has been developed through collaboration between State and Local governments to meet the region's current and future transport challenges. It integrates with the Greater Launceston Plan and City Deal Vision to achieve the overarching goal of making Launceston Australia's most liveable regional city.

A successful liveable city balances strategic focus towards creating a vibrant CBD as well as enhancing the overall community values across the greater Launceston region. Understanding that one cannot succeed without the other. Therefore, this Vision has a focus on ensuring that the same land use and transport planning principles are applied across local government boundaries to optimise the success of the region's transformation.

The Vision is underpinned by four themes; Integrated Transport, Land Use and Economic Planning; Greater Launceston Network Planning; Transport Options; and Primary Transport Corridors.

The Vision is further supported by six Liveability Elements that provide key guidance for transport objectives and will be used in the assessment of key initiatives and projects.





The Greater Launceston Vision Work Plan sets out a series of key actions already commenced, or proposed, by the Greater Launceston Councils, Tasmanian Government and Commonwealth Government.

The Work Plan includes key actions that are required to inform a strong evidence based approached to the development of a future Greater Launceston Transport Strategy and the delivery of key infrastructure planning and investigation initiatives.

The Work Plan also includes several infrastructure projects that are aimed at improving the transport needs and liveability of the region.

The structure of the Greater Launceston Vision Work Plan provides an understanding of how the action aligns to the Vision, its timing and delivery responsibility.





### How will we measure success?

The success of the Greater Launceston Transport Vision will be measured using the key performance indicators below. These performance measures are designed to look at the big picture. More detailed performance measures for specific actions will be included within those specific plans, such as the Launceston Transport Strategy and Network Operating Plans.

Although these performance indicators will form part of the Greater Launceston Transport Strategy they are likely to cover the below range of themes.

Theme	Adopted Key Performance Indicators				
Road Safety	Reduction in accidents, especially pedestrian accidents within high amenity areas				
Public transport	Increase percentage of the population who use the bus to commute to/from work.				
	Increase in the total number of bus shelters within the region.				
Major corridors	Travel time reliability from point to point along major road corridors (AM and PM peaks)				
Active transport	Increase in the kilometres of bike lanes and off road paths across the region.				
	Increase in the percentage of commuters who walk, ride or run to/from work.				
Freight	Reduce heavy vehicle accidents within urban areas. Improve the safety and efficiency of major freight corridors within the region.				
Employers	Increase the number of organisations with staff end of trip facilities for walking, cycling or running to/from work.				
Schools	Increase in the number of children walking or riding to/from school				
Parking	Improve the user experience for car parking within activity centres and CBD.				
Land use planning	Increase in the density of people living along public transport corridors.


