MY PLACE. COMMUNITY CONSULTATION

The City of Launceston is developing a plan for the future of living, working and playing in Invermay, Mowbray, Newnham, Mayfield, Rocherlea, Ravenswood and Waverley.

In August 2018, the community were invited to have their say on health and wellbeing, housing, transport and infrastructure and public spaces.

What did we ask?

We didn't want to ask the same questions again, so we looked at the information that we already had and identified topics that we thought were important. We then asked community members to rate the importance of these topics, as well as tell us any information that we don't have.

Who responded?

Of the 229 responses that we received to the question: Where do you live? 73% stated that they lived in the Northern Suburbs (with all seven suburbs represented), and 27% provided a response of 'other'.
