YEAR ONE OF IMPLEMENTATION

The My Place My Future Plan (MPMF Plan) was launched by the three levels of government in August 2019. The MPMF Plan lists strategies aimed at lifestyle, social and economic outcomes for those who live, work and play in Launceston's Northern Suburbs.

Several strategies are in progress with some initiatives already delivered by the City of Launceston, the Tasmanian Government, the Australian Government and the community.

THIS IS WHAT THE CITY OF LAUNCESTON DID BETWEEN AUGUST 2019 AND JUNE 2020

WE PROVIDED FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO:

- Communities to celebrate the launch of the MPMF Plan.
- The Local Area Advisory Group, created as part of the Our Community Our Care program.
- The Waverley Town Team Initiative.

WE KICKED-OFF ON:

- Developing implementation framework, plan and budget for the My Place My Future Plan.
- Working with a local company to develop a Social Enterprises Toolkit.
- Working on two Public Wi-Fi Pilot programs; one in Waverley, and one in Mowbray.
- Looking into what is required to revitalise old factory sites in the Northern Suburbs.
- Understanding what alternative transport services would be suitable for the Northern Suburbs.
- Working with community on potential new community garden sites.
- Setting up a Strategic Working Group. This allows people from the three levels of government to have specific conversations about the Northern Suburbs.

WE FINISHED:

- Developing a model for The Ignite You Pilot, a hands-on and reflective learning program focused on individuals and communities.
- Coordinating initial site reports for the Northern Suburbs Community Recreation Hub.

WE KEPT ON:

- Talking with private developers looking at opportunities in the Northern Suburbs.
- Looking into sites for a Defence Force Cadet Facility in the Northern Suburbs.
- Building strong relationships across the Northern Suburbs.
- Supporting existing programs.
- Promoting the needs of the area.

We were also successful in receiving a grant under the State Governments Community Road Safety Grants Program. This project will be delivered in conjunction with key community groups.

THIS IS WHAT WE WANTED TO DO BETWEEN AUGUST 2019 AND JUNE 2020, BUT DIDN'T (AND WHY).

- Progress was made in many areas, but some initiatives were temporarily placed on hold due to COVID-19, or delayed to ensure due diligence is in place. While this has resulted in some delays our commitments will still be delivered under the plan.
- We wanted to set up some grant programs for the Northern Suburbs. We weren't able to get these set up in time, but will keep working on this into the next 12 months. However, we were able to provide quick response seed funding to some great community initiatives.
- We wanted to be clearer about what the plans are for the Northern Suburbs Community Recreation Hub. However, getting all the required site reports took some time. You can expect to hear more about this into the next 12 months.
