**Road Owners consent for lodging application incorporating works within the road reserve:
Howard Street INVERMAY**

This letter, issued pursuant to Section 52(1B)(b) of the *Land Use Planning and Approvals Act 1993* is to confirm that the applicant has consent to lodge a development application with the Launceston City Council (the Council) that involves Council managed land, being Howard Street.

The proposal is to:

- Install a new industrial driveway in Montagu Street.
- Widen the existing driveway crossing.
- Remove the redundant driveway crossing and apron in Montagu Street and reinstate the kerb and channel, nature strip and footpath to match the existing adjacent construction.
- Construct new road junction.

The signing of this letter is not, in any way, an approval of the application or any works associated with the application, which must yet be determined under the provisions of the Tasmanian Planning Scheme - Launceston and will be required to comply with Council-adopted standards.

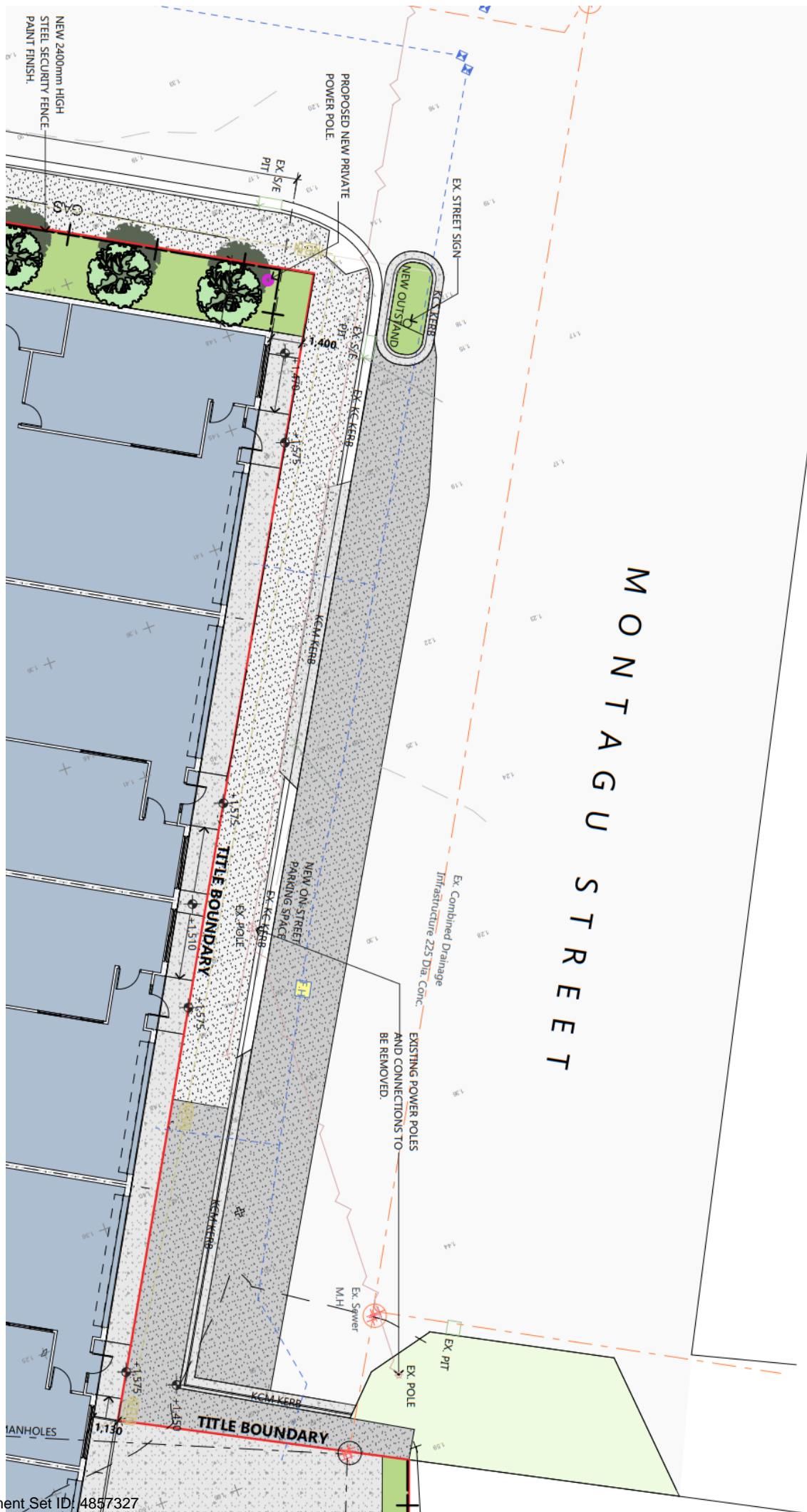
