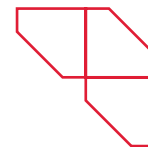


NTCA SPORTS COMPLEX REDEVELOPMENT



The opportunity

The City of Launceston is ready to redevelop the NTCA.

The project will upgrade one of Australia's most historic sporting venues. It will create modern facilities that support sport, recreation and community use across Northern Tasmania.

The project is shovel ready. Funding is the next step.

At the 20 August 2026 meeting; Council authorised officers an application to be made to the Growing Regions Program - Round 3.

Why change is needed
