Lifelong Registration Fee Option

A one-off registration fee can be paid for the life of your dog. To be eligible your dog must be microchipped. We require the chip number and a vet certificate (if desexed) at the time of registration.

Compulsory Microchipping

The *Dog Control Act 2000* requires all dogs over the age of six months to be microchipped. If a dog loses its collar with the registration details or a phone number attached, officers are still able to contact the owner by scanning the implanted microchip. **Failure to microchip your dog(s) may incur an on the spot Infringement Notice.**

Licence to Keep Several Dogs
