Items not permitted in your garbage bags:

- ✗ Hot ashes
- ✗ Oil, paint, chemicals, solvents and all other liquids
- ✗ Building rubble, car parts, large timber or metal
- ✗ Large volumes of grass clippings
- ✗ Batteries – car or household
