## **Licence to Keep Several Dogs - Information & Application**

Do you keep more than two dogs on your property? If so, you will need to have a Licence to keep several dogs.

To obtain a Licence please follow this procedure:

- 1. You must have the completed Advertisement Form published in the Public Notices section of The Examiner newspaper.
- Fill out your Licence Application. If you are not the owner of the property where the dogs will be kept, you must obtain written, signed consent from the property owner.
- 3. Cut out your advertisement from The Examiner newspaper, along with the date.
- 4. Send your completed Licence Application and newspaper cut out to:

A Council Regulations Officer will contact you after 28 days of your application being received, to arrange for an inspection of the property where the dogs are to be kept.

### Please Note:

- Applying for a licence does not guarantee you will get one. We will take into account:
  - Objections from residents living within 200 metres.
  - Any history of official complaints about nuisance dogs.
- If you are refused a licence you have the right to appeal before a magistrate at the Court of Petty Sessions.
- All dogs over 6 months of age must be registered and microchipped for a licence to be issued.
- You do not necessarily have to <u>own</u> all the dogs. If all the dogs are kept on one property then a licence is required.
- Licences expire on 31 July each year. There is a renewal fee which is reviewed each year.
- A penalty applies for not having a licence when required.
